

# Welcome to Rathbarry & Glenview Studs 2023



Dear Breeders.

Thankfully 2022 has seen the world returning to normality with the shadow of the Covid pandemic and its related difficulties becoming a distant memory. However, the Russian invasion of the Ukraine at the beginning of the year, is causing serious problems internationally and with no immediate resolution in sight, it seems we will have to live with the resultant upheaval for the foreseeable future. It is a testament to the resilience of the bloodstock industry that virtually all sales experienced positive results during the year and we hope that this trend will continue into 2023 to help defray the increased production costs hitting the industry.

We were very fortunate to acquire our exciting new stallion prospect **STATE OF REST** at the beginning of 2022 fresh from his wins in the US Gr.1 Saratoga Derby and the AUS Gr.1 Cox Plate. Under the expert guidance of Joseph O'Brien, he made an excellent start to 2022 by winning the Gr.1 Prix Ganay in France and then putting the icing on the cake with his convincing victory in the Gr.1 Prince of Wales's Stakes at Royal Ascot. It is no surprise that some of the most successful breeders in the Northern and Southern Hemispheres have invested in him and with their support, he must be an odds on prospect for a successful stud career.

In 2022 **ACCLAMATION** continued to be an ever deepening influence on thoroughbred breeding – siring the Champion Romantic Warrior in Hong Kong; his stallion sons delivering 20 Group/Grade 1 winners and his daughters producing 27 Individual Stakes winners. Having again had excellent fertility in 2022, we look forward to covering a restricted book of mares to him next season.

Having seen how **KODI BEAR** upgraded his mares in his first seasons at stud, it was no surprise that both his 2021 & 2022 books of mares, were the strongest so far in terms of both quality and quantity. Therefore it makes sense that this is the year to use him to capitalise on the quality of the stock he has to run for him going forward.

**JAMES GARFIELD** was one of the fastest 2 year olds of his generation and trained on to be a successful 3 year old. From limited opportunities, he has sired two black type dual winning performers from his first crop and had an overall strike rate of 72% winners/placed horses to runners. This strong start to his stud career was reflected at the 2022 yearling sales where his second crop sold to some of the shrewdest agents and trainers in the business.

Our very attractive roster of National Hunt Stallions at Glenview Stud features a mixture of proven stallions in **BLUE BRESIL**, **SHIROCCO** and **SHOLOKHOV**. From initial small foal crops, **BLUE BRESIL** has produced current exciting prospects such as Constitution Hill, Blue Lord, Royal Pagaille etc. and with the quality and quantity of his mares increasing since his arrival in Ireland, it would appear that his progeny will be a force to be reckoned with in years to come.

**SHIROCCO** continues to distinguish himself as a consistent source of talented jumpers, and with his large Irish jump bred crops now showing their talent, he should be guaranteed a leading place in the National Hunt Sires table for the future.

Already sire of 54 Flat and National Hunt Stakes performers, **SHOLOKHOV**'s progeny have given us some very special days at the Cheltenham Racing Festival and reading current reports, the trainers of Shishkin, Bob Olinger, Porticello etc. are confident of achieving further success in the 2022/2023 season.

Strong support from breeders in his first season at Glenview Stud should ensure that **YOUMZAIN** will have plenty of 4 year old runners on the track in 2023 to replenish the dwindling number of runners from his last flat bred crops in France. His progeny were purchased by some of the most respected agents and trainers in the business and we hope they will be well rewarded for their support.

In the past two years we have invested in new bloodlines for National Hunt breeders viz. **OLD PERSIAN** by Dubawi and **EAGLES BY DAY** by Sea The Stars. Both horses have been well supported by breeders and we look forward to seeing **OLD PERSIAN**'s first foals at the upcoming sales and to the arrival of **EAGLES BY DAY**'s first produce in 2023.

In conclusion, we are well aware and highly appreciative of the fact that our stallions' results and reputations, to a large extent, depend on the opportunities our clients give them and we hope that they will consider that we are offering quality and value again at Rathbarry & Glenview Studs for 2023.



It struck me over the weekend that there is a common thread that runs through so many of my Good Morning Bloodstock emails: a living legend of the Irish stallion ranks who is, perhaps, a tad underappreciated

despite making such a big impact on the breed. The horse in question is Rathbarry Stud stalwart Acclamation...

He is everywhere: the paternal grandsire of this year's King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes victor Pyledriver, 1,000 Guineas heroine Cachet and Poule d'Essai des Pouliches winner Mangoustine; a maternal great-grandsire of flying first-season sire Havana Grey; the sire of promising fellow freshman Expert Eye as well as record-breaking young stallion Mehmas; and in so many other pedigrees of note besides.

Acclamation is a great sire in his own right, supplying 144 black-type performers, including 63 stakes winners...

They are phenomenal figures for a stallion who might reasonably have been expected to be no more than an inexpensive but useful source of speed when he first retired to stud and has never shuttled to the southern hemisphere to boost his output.

But, as those aforementioned racing results this year are reminding us, it is Acclamation's ever-deepening influence that is most astonishing of all.

By my reckoning, his stallion sons have delivered 18 Group/Grade 1 winners on the Flat between them, with the prolific Dark Angel doing most of the heavy lifting by accounting for 11 of those – Alfareeq, Althiqa, Angel Bleu, Battaash, Harry Angel, Hunt, Lethal Force, Mangoustine, Mecca's Angel, Persuasive and Raging Bull.

The other seven came from Equiano (Belvoir Bay and The Tin Man), Harbour Watch (Pyledriver and Waikuku), Mehmas (Going Global and Supremacy) and Aclaim (Cachet)...

Acclamation has also proved a force for good in the bottom half of pedigrees. He is damsire of two pairs of high-class brothers, in Broome and Point Lonsdale and Eqtidaar and Massaat, as well as highflyers Rohaan, San Donato and True Valour...

Anyway, you should have got the picture by now: Acclamation has become an extremely potent force in pedigrees.

### A Living Legend

Acclamation as only the most influential stallions do, continues to make his presence felt both on the track and across the breeding world.

His progeny's own success on the track in 2022 was headlined by **Romantic Warrior**, who completed a prestigious double in the Hong Kong Derby and Group 1 QEII Cup. Seven wins from eight starts saw the four-year-old earn three titles at the Hong Kong Champion Awards; Champion Middle Distance Horse, Champion Four-Year-Old and Most Improved Horse. HKJC to whom Romatic Warrior was knocked down to for the princely sum of 300,000gns as a yearling were again active in securing the progeny of Acclamation in the 2022 yearling sales signing for one of the top lots at the Goffs UK premier sale.

Acclamation continues to be a source of smart juveniles, as demonstrated this season by Listed winner **Beauty Crescent** and Group 2 Mill Reef Stakes second **Rousing Encore**.

It comes as no surprise, then, that Acclamation's progeny continued to be in high demand at the 2022 yearling sales, where they sold for up to £200,000. His daughters also commanded high prices at the breeding stock sales, with broodmare prospect **Louliana** bringing €320,000 from Shadai Farm.

Acclamation's influence as a damsire continued in 2022, as advertised by seven Stakes winners, including Broome, Jumby, Txope and Rohaan. At the time of writing, his sons are responsible for 20 Group/Grade 1 winners between them, with Aclaim becoming his latest stallion success story when daughter Cachet captured the 1,000 Guineas.

Acclamation is, as Martin Stevens so eloquently put it in the Racing Post, "a living legend of the Irish stallion ranks."



### First Crop 3-Y-O's

James Garfield's first crop made a bright start in 2022 and saw him become the first freshman stallion to sire a Stakes winner when **Maria Branwell** took the Listed Coral National Stakes at Sandown.

David O'Meara's charge made it two from two in the five furlong sprint, and the form was boosted when the 104-rated runner-up Crispy Cat finished third in the Group 2 Norfolk Stakes. Maria Branwell went on to finish third in the Group 2 Queen Mary Stakes, which earned her an official rating of 100.

**Lady Bullet** (James Garfield) also won her first two starts and gained valuable black-type when finishing third in the Listed Blenheim Stakes won by Beauty Crescent (Acclamation).


At the time of writing, James Garfield is a joint fourth in the GB & IRE freshman sires table based on black-type horses, despite having had less runners than those above him in the standings. His promising start with his first crop of two-year-olds is made all the more exciting given that he himself improved as a three-year-old.

The well-bred son of Exceed And Excel set a juvenile track record in the Group 2 Mill Reef Stakes. On his 3-Y-O return in the Group 3 Greenham Stakes, he ended the unbeaten run of Expert Eye the subsequent winner of the Breeders' Cup Mile. James Garfield himself was narrowly denied Group 1 glory close home in the Prix Maurice de Gheest, where five Group 1 winners chased him home.

James Garfield's fine start at stud was evident at the 2022 yearling sales, where his second crop were purchased by some of the shrewdest operators in the business incl. Joe Foley, Richard Knight, Sean Quinn, Clive Cox, Manor House Farm, Con Marnane, Peter Nolan, Noel Meade, etc.



### Eye to the Future

It would appear that the best is yet to come from exciting young sire Kodi Bear.

A leading first and second crop sire, the talented son of Kodiac impressed many by upgrading his first mares, which yielded three Group 1 performers, each of whom were the first black-type produce of their dams. Additionally, four of his Stakes performers are out of maiden or unraced mares.

Breeders' took note of his early success at stud, resulting in quality books of Black Type mares being covered in recent seasons which include: the dams of Classic performers and Group winners and half sisters to Group 1/Group 2 winners.

The dam of multiple Stakes-placed **Helens Well** has since returned to the sire, as have the dams of Epsom Oaks runner-up **Mystery Angel**, Group 1 sprinter **Measure Of Magic** and unbeaten Stakes winner **Diablotine**.

Kodi Bear remains as popular with buyers as breeders, with his yearlings selling for up to 210,000gns in 2022. Purchasers of his yearlings in 2022 included: Kevin Ryan, Marco Bozzi, Nick Bradley Racing, Charlie Gordon Watson Bloodstock, Peter & Ross Doyle Bloodstock, Joe Foley, Jason Kelly Bloodstock/ Sean Quinn, etc. His proven horses were also in demand, commanding prices up to £340,000.

Group 2 Winning Juvenile **Go Bears Go** proved himself a class performer at three, winning the Group 3 Commonwealth Cup Trial Stakes and the Phoenix Sprint Stakes collecting second in between to the Group 1 Haydock Sprint Cup victor Minzaal. **Ever Given** was another that impressed in 2022 when winning the Listed Surrey Stakes and placing in both the Group 3 Qatar Prix Du Pin and Criterion Stakes.



### New for 2023

Four -Time Gr.1 Winner State Of Rest is the latest exciting addition to the Rathbarry Stud roster for 2023.

A debut winner in June over 6 furlongs in his juvenile campaign, State Of Rest went on to finish third in the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes and culminated his season when finishing fifth in the Gr.1 Vertem Futurity Trophy Stakes.

State Of Rest made giant strides during his 3-Y-O campaign winning the Gr.1 Saratoga Derby and completing a remarkable top-flight double in the Gr.1 Cox Plate. His victory in the latter was made even more impressive as he conceded 16lbs to runner up Anamoe who landed the 2022 running of the Cox Plate.

State Of Rest confirmed himself a class performer on his 4-Y-O return when gaining his third Gr.1 victory in the Prix Ganay.

Subsequently a gallant third in the Gr.1



Blue Bresil continued to go from strength to strength through the 2021/2022 season, during which he sired a career-best number of black-type winners.

His son **Constitution Hill** proved a class apart in the novice hurdle division, with a pair of Grade 1 wins by a combined margin of 34 lengths earning him a mark of 170 - the highest rating awarded to a novice hurdler since classifications were introduced and he was also crowned the top rated hurdler of the 2021/2022 season. Looking towards the upcoming season, Nicky Henderson said of his star, "I can't stress how brilliant his temperament is. That allows his talent to flow – and that talent is extraordinary. The aim, unsurprisingly, is the Champion Hurdle and a clash with Honeysuckle, which should be something to savour."

Colin Bowe's success with **Willmount** a winner on debut at Comea Point to Point and top priced lot selling for £340,000 at the Cheltenham February sales, resulted in Colin signing for four of Blue Bresil's progeny at the 2022 store sales.

Blue Bresil was also responsible for the highest-priced filly and joint top lot overall at the Goffs Land Rover Sale, where he had three of the top ten lots and boasted a median price of €120,000. His fillies also proved popular at the British sales, as they sold for up to £90,000 at the Goffs UK Yorton Sale and £88,000 at the Goffs UK Spring Store Sale.







The beautifully-bred son of Dubawi himself hails from the top-class Niarchos family of Kingmambo, Alpha Centauri, Alpine Star and Miesque and is out of a full-sister to Group 2 Ribblesdale Stakes heroine Silkwood. A grandson of top broodmare sire Singspiel, he is bred on the same cross as fellow top-level winners Left Hand, Too Darn Hot and Wuheida. Dubawi, responsible for over 50 individual Group/Grade 1 winners on the flat, has also sired the multiple Grade 1 winning Chaser Dodging Bullets, dual Grade 1 winning Hurdler Hisaabaat and Grade 2 winning Purple Bay, who also claimed second in the Grade 1 Christmas Hurdle.

Old Persian, twice a winner over 8f at two, added the Listed Fairway Stakes over 10f and Group 2 contests King Edward VII Stakes at Royal Ascot and the Great Voltigeur Stakes at York over 12f to his CV the following year. He confirmed himself a class performer over 12f as a four-year-old when taking the Group 2 Dubai City of Gold Stakes at Meydan followed by the Group 1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan and the Grade 1 Northern Dancer Turf Stakes at Woodbine, collecting third in the Group 1 Grosser Preis von Berlin in between.





Both codes, both hemispheres, both as sire and grandsire: Glenview Stud stalwart Shirocco has really shown his versatility in the past week...

While Shirocco might not have been

represented by a superstar of Annie Power's magnitude in recent years – which is clearly a lot to ask, anyway – he has nonetheless distinguished himself as a consistent source of talented jumpers.

Results from the Cheltenham Festival last week reminded us of that, as the sire's five runners at the meeting yielded Pertemps Final winner Third Wind (bred by owner Mouse Hamilton-Fairley during his last year at Dalham Hall Stud) and narrowly beaten Close Brothers Mares'

Hurdle runner-up Queens Brook (bred by Richella Rohan during his debut season at Glenview Stud).

Third Wind and Queens Brook are among a haul of 37 black-type National Hunt performers by Shirocco, and they continue a strong season for him in which he is sitting in fourth place in the leading sires' table.

It's easy to forget just how long it takes for a jumps stallion to establish himself, and I would venture that it's still relatively early days for Shirocco's purely National Hunt-bred crops...

So I wouldn't rule out Shirocco climbing higher in the sire standings in the near future as he has more jumps-bred crops competing at the same time, and subsequently enjoying another spike in popularity in his twilight years ...Shirocco, a truly top-class horse who has made a big impact in jumps and flat racing, still deserves his fair portion of patronage.

### A Career Best

Shirocco was crowned leading sire of the 2021/22 Irish PTP season with an impressive 25 wins to his name. He also celebrated a career-best tally under rules by winners, black-type winners and prize money.

Shirocco has been enjoying a steady rise through the NH stallion ranks in recent years, with his first crop conceived in Ireland yielding 14 black-type performers. Eleanor Manning's **Dysart Diamond** is one of those 14, and kicked off last season with a valuable victory in a Gr.B hurdle worth €80,000, before following up at Listed level at Punchestown.

Chicago Time and Off Your Rocco continued Shirocco's fantastic start to the season by each scoring at Listed level over hurdles. The 2022/23 season has begun in similar fashion, with **Troubled Times** landing a Listed mares' bumper at Gowran for Sam Curling.

Lily Du Berlais and Good Time Jonny put Shirocco's name in lights at Leoparstown's Dublin Racing Festival, where they notched a Gr.2 and €100,000 Gr.B win apiece. Fortescue continued the fine run for his sire in the Listed Swinley Chase, while Third Wind recorded his third Graded success in the Gr.3 Pertemps Network Final at the Cheltenham Festival.

Shirocco's brilliant season between the flags followed through to the sales where the impressive debut 5YO PTP winners Alfie's Princess and De Legislator realised £220,000 and €170,000 respectively, while Evan Williams went to £160,000 to secure Out of Office who won the 4YO maiden at Belharbour on his debut. In 2019, Aidan Fitzgerald sold Queens Brook for £160,000 following her win at Dromahane and she went on to be placed at Gr.1 level for Gordon Elliott. There was a sense of déjà vu surrounding Queens Vic's 14 L win at the same track, as there was with her £175,000 sale to Elliott, Joey Logan and Andy Brown.





# How to find us...

### Using the M8 Motorway Bypass

From Dublin: On M8 South Route from Dublin, Exit Junction 15 signposted for Fermoy & Rathcormac. At roundabout take 1st exit followed immediately by 1st turn left signposted Castlelyons - Rathbarry Stud (5m/8km) and Glenview Stud (3m/5km).

From Cork: On M8 North Route from Cork, Exit at Junction 15 signposted for Fermoy and take 3rd exit off roundabout, go under flyover bridge and at 2nd roundabout take 1st exit followed immediately by 1st turn left signposted Castlelyons - Rathbarry Stud (5m/8km) and Glenview Stud (3m/5km).

### Avoiding the M8 Motorway Bypass

On M8 South Route from Dublin, Exit at Junction 14 signposted for Fermoy, go into Fermoy, on N8 South Route. Take N72 for Waterford/Tallow at lights in the Square. Continue on N72 for (3m/5km) to McDonnells Grain store. Turn right here on to road for Coolagown and continue to T junction and then take left for Rathbarry (1m/1.5km) and right for Glenview (2m/3km).

Alternatively, on the N8 South Route, take N8 for Cork at lights in the Square in Fermoy. At first roundabout take second exit going under flyover bridge. At 2nd roundabout, take 1st exit followed immediately by 1st turn left signposted for Castlelyons - Rathbarry Stud (5m/8km) and Glenview Stud (3m/5km).
